# A Moment in Time

## Sponsorship & Donations

- You can sponsor "A Moment in Time" with a donation of £5.00. For this you will receive a certificate, which will show your "Unique Moment in Time" (A Minute of a Day). Your donation will also be recorded in a special Register for this project. You can select your "Moment" to commemorate a birth time or some other event and if that time has not been taken, then it will be "Unique". Otherwise it can be shared with someone else.
- We are seeking Corporate or Individual sponsors for a donation of £250 for the sponsorship of each set of Roman Numerals on the Clock face. We are seeking twelve such donations, which will raise £3,000 towards this project. A certificate will also be issued along with an entry in the special Register for this project. By the 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2011, six numbers have been sponsored. Alternatively, smaller donations of over £30 can be shared sponsorship and currently number "VIII" is being used for this with three sponsors so far.
- Other individual Donations of any amount can be made for either the restoration of the Clock face or specifically for the restoration and preservation of the Clock Mechanism.

# BANK HALL CLOCK PROJECT

*"Bank Hall Action Group" is a voluntary organisation affiliated to "The Heritage Trust for the North West" (Registered Charity Number: 508300) and is working for the Restoration of Bank Hall at Bretherton.*

*"The Bank Hall Clock Project" was launched in 2008 (The 400<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year of the oldest part of the present building) to raise funds to restore the North facing Clock Face on the Clock Tower at Bank Hall and to preserve what remains of the Georgian Clock mechanism of the original Clock.*

*The monies raised in this appeal will be held in a separate account until the Project proceeds.*

*If the project does not proceed, the sponsorship monies for the Roman numerals donations will be returned to each of the 12 Donors. The Bank Hall Action Group will retain any other funds raised from this appeal and will apply the same towards the restoration and preservation of the clock mechanism and other artifacts from the Hall.*
